RECOMMENDATION: CONDITIONAL BID

Good strategic fit, but do not start response assembly until the viability gates below are closed.

- 1 Deadline conflict.** SAM.gov shows 31 Aug 2026 at 11:00 a.m. Central; SF1449 block 8 shows 28 Aug at 12:00 local. Ask the Contract Specialist which controls. Manage to the earlier time until the answer is in writing.
- 2 Mandatory site visit.** Confirm scheduling, attendee requirements, and whether one visit covers both Houston and Galveston performance locations.
- 3 Location inconsistency.** The notice references a post-award conference in South Padre Island. Confirm whether that is a template error before relying on the document set.

CONFIRMED IN THE NOTICE

- Total small-business set-aside under NAICS 561710
- Firm-fixed-price base year plus four option years
- Monthly pest-control service across Houston and Galveston
- Lowest-price, technically acceptable evaluation
- Active SAM.gov registration required

NEXT FOUR ACTIONS

- 1 Clarify**
Get the controlling deadline in writing.
- 2 Schedule**
Book the mandatory site visit and confirm coverage.
- 3 Route**
Confirm territory, license, capacity, and pricing with the local operator.
- 4 Assemble**
Build only the response the solicitation actually requests.

RESPONSIVE FIRST. THEN PRICE.

Under LPTA, the lowest evaluated price wins only among technically acceptable offers. Map the required format and acceptability standards first. Do not add an elaborate narrative or attachments unless the solicitation or Contract Specialist requires them.
